LUND TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES
APRIL 9, 2019

As part of public comment, Carol McKenzie read a letter from Gary Perea concerning his views about the City with fire and EMS county protection and citizens welfare. In his letter he is not in support of the current proposal and stating that it will give total county emergency response to the City of Ely and the downfalls this will create. Lee Ringueberg made a motion to approve the minutes of March 12 2019, Ann Hamilton seconded that motion and members approved.

Christina Rimington made a motion to approve the one voucher for payment, secretary's wages voucher, Lee seconded the motion and all members approved.
