MEETING MINUTES

MEMBERS PRESENT: Jacob Carter, Craig Baker, Mary Kerner, Dana Johnson, Mark Tefft, Bill Wilson

PUBLIC PRESENT: Bill Miller, Laurie Carson, White Pine County Commission, Elanie Calderwood

- I. **Call to Order:** Jacob Carter called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
- II. **Pledge of Allegiance and Introductions**
- III. **Public Comment:** None were made.
- IV. ***Discussion/for Possible Action - Approval of March 10, 2020 Meeting Minutes:** Mark Tefft made a motion to approve the March 10, 2020 meeting minutes, noting that due to COVID-19 an April meeting was not held. Bill Wilson seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- V. **Liaison Report** Laurie Carson reported that BLM is currently not open to the public, so none of the meeting is being held such as CRM. Jose Noriega is waiting on direction regarding the OHV sub-group working on the OHV plan. The commission is working with Jeremy Drew from RCI on fuels reduction and sage grouse. Laurie further explained that Resource Concepts, Inc. is the Natural Resource contract company, they are on a retainer with a not to exceed amount. Jeremy Drew is the main contact for White Pine County, if there is an item that the advisory committee would like to have research to reach out to Laurie and she will get in contact with Jeremy.
- VI. ***Discussion/for Possible Action**
 - A. ***Update/Discussion/for Possible Action – Bureau of Land Management:** No one from BLM was present.
 - B. ***Update/Discussion/for Possible Action – U.S. Forest Service:** No one from USFS was present.
 - C. ***Update/Discussion/for Possible Action – National Park Service** No one from NPS was present.

D. ***Update/Discussion/for Possible Action – Nevada State Parks** No one from NSP was present.

- VII. ***Discussion/for Possible Action – Review The White Pine County Public Lands Management Plan, OHV Section, to establish a County-Wide OHV Policy, using the CRM process.** Dana Johnson suggested that there should be an alternate for PLUAC on the CRM, in case he is unable to attend. Mary Kerner volunteered to be the alternate. The next CRM meeting is tentatively set for June 5, 2020. Laurie Carson reported that Jose Noriega will be taking the lead on coordinating the CRM process for the OHV policy. Dana Johnson asked if Bruce Eldridge and been contact to see if he would be willing to work on the OHV policy, it was not known if he had.
- VIII. ***Discussion/Action – Updates, Issues Contained in White Pine County’s Public Land Use Policies Including OHV Use, Energy, Minerals, Water, Land Sales, Greater Sage-Grouse, and Wild Horse and Burros.** Laurie Carson reported that on the next day’s County Commission is the second reading of the ordinance that horses and burros are not greater or equal to livestock. Bill Wilson reported that KGHM has extended the mine line to 2027 and has expanded to open the Liberty Pit. Bill also reported that there are two applications for permits to drill for oil & gas in Newark Valley.
- IX. ***Discussion/Action – Committee Vacancies, Resignations, and Appointments** There currently is one vacancy on the advisory committee which is to represent Tourism.
