Chairman, Jim Allred, brought the meeting to order at 6pm at Lund Community Bldg. All board members were present. Guests- Christina and Ray Sawyer.

Public Comment: Lee Ringueberg wanted to report on the weed problem that has not been addressed and now it is a real problem along the roads throughout Lund. Jim Allred volunteered to talk to Tri-County Weed and see if they can help. Lee mentioned that she would donate the use of her propane tank and weed burner if the need arises.

Christina Rimington approved the minutes of July 10 2018 meeting, Ann Hamilton seconded that motion and all board members approved motion.

There were vouchers for Kris Jackson for cemetery maintenance for the months of August, September and October presented for payment approval and Secretary's wages voucher. Lee made a motion to approve vouchers for payment, Ann seconded that motion and all board members approved.

Lee reported that street light on Main Street #11 light had not been replaced when the pole was destroyed by a fallen tree. Lee will call and see if the light can be replaced.

There was no report concerning the town's road conditions.

Lee reported that the building was heavily used throughout July and everything went smoothly.

Public Comment: Jim Allred voiced his concerns with Ray Sawyer about the traffic thru Lund on Hwy 318, the high rate of speed the motorist are going through town. Jim and council asked if there could be more support from the sheriff's office in trying to protect our town and get safety issues to be a priority. The board also mentioned about some criminal activity that happens in White River Valley, seems to go unchecked, the council would like to see it become a priority with the law enforcement efforts.

Ann Hamilton asked about trying to plant trees at the west end of the Community Bldg property. The board discussed this and suggested a letter be written to White Pine Co. School District in obtaining permission for this to be done. Ann will send the letter and report back if there is a response from the School District. Christina mentioned that she went to the Ruth park and saw the improvements there and had some ideas when more action was going to be done for the Lund area.

Carol reported about a list of suggestions that was given to the Nevada Dept of Transportation from the W.P.Co. Commissioners for the highways in the county.

Lee made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Christina seconded it and all members approved.
