Discussion/Action: Melissa Spear: Charge of speed to 15 miles per hour. Chairman Spear ask what people think of this? Phil Winsryg stated that he thought it would punish the people that are driving the speed limit, he feels we need to get more speed signs on Keystone, Sunshine and Hill Street. A motion was made by Phil Winsryg not to change the speed but get more speed signs, second by Johnathan Dishong and carried by the members present.

Discussion/Action: Melissa Spear: Possible placement of a speed bump on Sunshine Street. It was decided that more speed signs will give the Sheriff's Office fine people for speeded on our street. This died for lack of a motion.

Public Commit: Mary Sorenson stated he has looked into a small grant that can help us with cleaning and leveling with the lot and then we can look into a big on in the fall. Chairman Spear stated that his will be the last meeting for Katelin Mason she will be moving to Wyoming.

With no further business a motion to close the meeting was made by Phil Winsryg seconded by Johnathan Dishong and carried by the members present. The meeting was closed at 8:45 p.m.
