

Lund Town Council
Meeting Sept 11 2018
Minutes

Vice-Chairman Ann Hamilton brought the meeting to order, since Chairman Jim Allred was absent. Those present were, Ann Hamilton, Lee Ringueberg, Lance Matheson, Christina Rimington, Carol McKenzie, Ray Sawyer and Charis Maynard.

Ann asked if there was any public comment at this time. Ann reported that she was drafting a letter to the White Pine County Superintendent Adam Young to seek permission to plant some shade trees on the West side of the property of Lund Community Bldg, since the property is still owned by the school district. She will be stating the types of trees, location and maintenance plan for the trees as well as, being planted by volunteers. She asked for any opinions and additions that may be helpful in the letter, she will send it this week and hope to report back to the Council at the next meeting.

After some discussion about the previous minutes, Christina Rimington made a motion to approve the minutes as read, Lee Ringueberg seconded the motion and all board members present approved.

One voucher for request of payment was presented, for Secretary's wages, Christina made a motion to approve payment, Lee seconded that motion and all members approved.

Lee reported on the street lights, said she contacted Mt. Wheeler Power to discuss the pole taken down Main street north, by Tim Moser's residence, since the pole was down the street light did not get replaced on the new pole. Lee said MTWP told her that the smaller pole that was used in replacement would not hold a new street light but if the Council wanted a new street light on a different pole the Council would be liable for the costs. After some discussion the members agreed to take some time during the evening hours and see if a new light is needed as well as maybe some additional lights that could be useful and to report at the next meeting and a decision would be made at that time.

There was no news to report on road conditions. Lee reported that the community building is staying consistently busy with reservations and a new vacuum is needed due to the wear and tear of being used often. The members are looking into and new commercial type and will discuss at the next meeting.

There was no additional public comment to report. Christina made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Lance Matheson seconded that motion and all members approved.
