

The Southern Nevada Public Land Management Act (SNPLMA) became law in October 1998. It allows the Bureau of Land Management to sell public land within a specific boundary around Las Vegas, Nevada. Some of the funds generated from these sales allows for the creation of local parks, trails, and natural areas (PTNA) in Nevada through SNPLMA grants. These projects are implemented by the eligible partner agencies to benefit communities and public lands throughout the State of Nevada.

The White Pine County Commission will consider potential projects for the SNPLMA PTNA Round 18 at the April 11, 2018 Commission Meeting.
