

Remote Appearances in Criminal Cases

Generally, the Court favors allowing a party or witness to appear remotely for a criminal matter.

If you are the defendant in the criminal matter and wish to appear remotely, you should discuss the possibility with your attorney. If you are a witness in a criminal matter, and wish to appear remotely, you should contact the party who subpoenaed (or otherwise made arrangements for your testimony) and discuss the possibility with him/her. If you are simply wishing to observe the proceedings remotely, please contact the Court to discuss the possibility.

The Court has provided the phone numbers of the prosecutor and defense attorneys who most frequently participate in criminal matters. The attorney you need to speak to may not be the attorney listed below and you may have to make efforts to contact the appropriate attorney.

Please be advised, due to constitutional considerations, remote attendance may not be possible.
