Minutes of Meeting for

Mar. 9, 2021

After the pledge, Chairman Jim Allred brought the meeting to order. Candice Perez started the Public Comment requesting \$400 for the annual Community Easter Egg Hunt on March 27<sup>th</sup>, 2021 @ 10AM. After discussing the budget it was motioned by Christina Rimington to give them \$350 and was seconded by Lance Matheson, then approved by all members. Jim Allred brought up abandoned cars from last months meeting and mentioned that there are 14 houses in town that are over that limit.

Lee Ringueberg made a motion to approve the minutes of February 9, 2021 as written, Christina Rimington seconded that motion and all members approved.

Christina Rimington made a motion to approve secretary's wages, Lee Ringueberg seconded and all members approved.

Ann Hamilton mentioned Frank Reid asked about removing the large tree stumps below Roy and Sherri Faught's home.

Gilbert Griffin opened the Public Comment section asked Jared Bybee- Field Manager for the BLM, if they had a legal aspect of creating a safety zone or fire protection area on the BLM land surrounding the town. Jared Bybee mentioned fuels treatment and EIS (Environmental Impact Statement) for fire breaks. He suggested emailing the BLM and CC: Richard Howe telling of our concern and see what they can do to help. It was also discussed bringing dumpsters down for clean up revealed by the fire surrounding Lund last June. Shawn Hamilton asked Jared Bybee if there was a possibility of BLM land for use of possibly a local landfill. Jared mentioned the White Pine Green Up Clean Up Grant that could possibly help.
