Minutes of Meeting for

April 13, 2021

After the pledge, Chairman Jim Allred brought the meeting to order. Ann Hamilton started the Public Comment by mentioning the stumps below the Faught residence. Christina Rimington brought up that Shawn Hamilton mentioned he would load them up and take them away. It was suggested by Jim Allred to buy a new recorder for the Town Council Secretary for the recording of meeting minutes.

Lee Ringueberg made a motion to approve the minutes of March 9, 2021 as written, Ann Hamilton seconded that motion and all members approved.

Vouchers for Easter Committee requested \$350, Lee Ringueberg for stamps \$55, and secretary's wages \$100 were motioned by Christina Rimington, Lance Matheson seconded and all members approved. Kris Jackson cemetery wages will be taken care of in May meeting.

Jim Allred opened the Public Comment mentioning he called Bill Calderwood about putting a dumpster in town for cleanup. He left a message and hasn't talked to him yet but per messages it will be easier to spend money on a dumpster to put at the bottom of the square. It will not be for hazardous materials or appliances but all other garbage. When the dumpster arrives we will let the town's people know via Lund Friends on facebook, flyers posted in Whipple's, Post Office and Carter Ag, and also through word of mouth. Jim Allred also mentioned obtaining an email address for the Director of DOT. Emailing Mrs. Swallow for LED speed limit signs to put on each end of town. If DOT will not buy then we will consider buying them ourselves.
