Minutes of Meeting for

June 13, 2023

Jimmy Allred brought meeting to order at 6:05PM.

Pledge of Allegiance done.

Public Comment: Jimmy mentioned he has been Lund Town Council President for a few years and suggested that since Lorin Peacock has a lot of energy maybe he could be the new President. This will be added to the agenda for next month to vote on. Jimmy also mentioned that we pay a lot in taxes and should see more presence from the county. Ann Hamilton asked Jimmy if he has sprayed the weeds, he said yes and will be spraying again soon. Lorin asked if it kills goatheads, Jimmy said yes but it doesn't kill the seeds.

Approval of minutes from last meeting motioned by Christina Rimington and seconded by Ann. All members present approved.

Lorin mentioned that the cemetery looks great, they will approve the second half of summer wages for Matt Carter next month. Vouchers for payment, secretary wages, motioned by Lorin and seconded by Lee Ringueberg. All members present approved.

Water leak by the Carter's was brought up again by Ann. Megan has written a letter to the Water Board and it has been sent. For the next town cleanup Jimmy will bushbeat and spray for weeds, hopefully this will help. Jimmy talked to the county about the latch at the tree dump, it was broken by someone, sweeping the streets and the dumpster. He still hasn't heard back from Mike Wheable. Lee and Ann haven't noticed any streetlight problems.

Lorin mentioned the next town cleanup will be on June 30 from 6-8PM. They will be starting around Christina's house and continue working north. We will continue these cleanups and hope that it helps motivate people to work on their own yards. Don McKenzie may be willing to let us help with tree trimming. Lee isn't able to help at this time but is willing to let others borrow equipment she has.

Public Comment: Lorin asked Christina what do we need to put up the flag? She mentioned the ones she bought came with poles to attach to the power poles. Flags are 3'x5' in size. Lee asked if anyone has talked to Mt. Wheeler, no one has yet.
