

Lund Town Council
Minutes of Meeting for
September 12, 2023

Ann Hamilton brought meeting to order at 6:15PM.

Pledge of Allegiance done.

Public Comment: None

Approval of minutes from last meeting motioned by Lorin Peacock and seconded by Moroni Perez. All members present approved.

Vouchers for payment, secretary wages, motioned by Ann and seconded by Katie Carter. All members present approved.

Lee mentioned that the street lights are okay. Ann said highway signs and road conditions are currently okay. NDOT is still working on culverts in town. Katie asked what needs to be done to fix the Just Center that has started to lose siding. Who do we contact and who would come remove or fix. Lee will call the county and see who can fix it. Laine Hendrix and Russ Peacock may possibly still have keys to it. Lorin asked if they could turn it over to the Town Council to use as storage. Lee will ask.

Moroni asked from the fire department if we could donate \$1500.00 for their 2023 fireworks program that they still owe. Megan will work on the paperwork to approve next month.

Ann asked if there is a possibility of getting another street light added up at Lance Mathesons corner. Lee to call and check up on it. Possibly to add 12 lights to current poles on back street.

Public Comment: Christina talked to Burton Hilton (County Assessor) about annexing people into town limits. (NRS269.650) Town Council or County Commission to pass ordinance and survey map. Once passed and map filed then this can be completed. Moroni asked what the cost is to rezone and surveyor costs. Griffins are interested in joining town limits, Hendrix and Sabaitis also interested in joining town limits. Lorin mentioned BJ Almberg may possibly do it pro bono. Christina suggested to maybe invite Burton and BJ to a Town Council meeting and ask. Lorin mentioned more people in town limits equals more budget, a break in home insurance, more people to be a part of the town council. Property taxes aren't a town thing, just a county.

Lorins update on the shooting range. BJ has a legal description and gave it to Jared Bybee at the BLM. Alicia Hankins has it under review. Our current choice of property is not currently available. Lorin will meet with the BLM on October 5 for an update.

Lorin proposed assigning projects to each member of the town council. Jimmy – weeds and museum lot. Ann & Lee – streetlights, road signs, community building. Lorin – shooting range. Katie – Christmas lights and kids park. Christina – town beautification, do things on main street, benches, add nice things to town, look into grants. Moroni – annexation and dump. Each month come with an update on your area.

Add to next months agenda, election of officers.

Lee motioned to adjourn, Christina seconded and all members approved. The next meeting will be on October 14, @ 6pm @ the Lund Community Building.
