Minutes of Meeting for

October 10, 2023

Chairman Jimmy Allred brought meeting to order at 6:00PM.

Pledge of Allegiance done.

Public Comment: Gilbert Griffin asked if the Pioneer Day committee came to request money for 24<sup>th</sup> Fireworks from July. Moroni Perez mentioned that Fire Department came last month and it will be mentioned in today's meeting.

Approval of minutes from last meeting motioned by Lorin Peacock and seconded by Ann Hamilton. All members present approved.

Vouchers for payment, 24<sup>th</sup> Fireworks, secretary supplies and secretary wages, motioned by Lee Ringueberg and seconded by Lorin. All members present approved.

Lorin mentioned that he has talked to Kevin Robinson at Wheeler about streetlights and cost of adding new ones. He is hoping to make one of our upcoming Town Council meetings to discuss it. Gilbert mentioned that this years 24<sup>th</sup> cleanup went well but is wondering if Town Council could allocate funds and hire out for someone to come spray weeds so we aren't having to clean those up during the Town cleanup. Maybe be done in late spring and early summer. Jimmy mentioned that he did spray the back streets 3 times and only did main street once due to time restrictions. Lorin said he could possibly help with getting more of the weeds sprayed on main street. We could talk about it next April or May and add it to our monthly agenda. Lorin to possibly organize a few nights to spray last 6'-8' of weeds to peoples property line that tractor cannot reach with a hand sprayer.

Jimmy asked Gilbert if he would be interested in going to the County Commission and work on getting a White River Valley County Commission rep. It was originally cancelled years ago due to not enough interest from outlying communities. We in Lund should have more representation from our community due to the taxes we pay. Gilbert mentioned that we need someone to run and back up what is presented and be in for the long term.

Lorin mentioned that we need to pick a date to put up town Christmas decorations. All agreed on October 21 @ 1PM, meet at the community center. Megan will put up flyers and post on social media.

Lee, Ann and Lorin all went to the County Commission to ask about the Justice of the Peace building here in Lund that is falling apart. Commission mentioned that they will come and remove the building.

Lee mentioned that we need to nominate Lorin to be new Chairperson. Ann & Jimmy have done a fantastic job for the last 6-8 years. Lee nominated Lorin to be the new Chairperson, was seconded by Jimmy. All present approved. Lee motioned Moroni to be the new Vice Chairperson, seconded by Lorin. All members present approved. A job well done to all our Town Council members who put in the effort to make our community successful.

Public Comment: Lorin met with BLM last week, they will help with what they can. They mentioned we could use the old dump property, it will only be 400 yards, but once established we can go back to the BLM and extend to 1200 yards. Once all approved they will have LLC and be able to qualify for grants in May 2024.

Megan to check with Katie Carter about Christmas flags because they will need to be ordered soon.

Moroni mentioned the annexation, he still needs to contact Burton Hilton. Laine Hendrix is willing to allow us to put metal above Dave's property to be collected. Gilbert asked if annexation occurs does that add more county tax that stay s here to be utilized? Moroni will get calculations on that.

Megan asked if the Community Christmas budget can be raised from \$350 to \$500. Sheila Allred and Jill Horsley are using the full budget but needing to use coupons and sales to be able to afford gifts for all the children. Town Council approved to raise and will be submitted next month.

Lee motioned to adjourn, Lorin seconded and all members approved. The next meeting will be on November 14, @ 6pm @ the Lund Community Building.
