Minutes of Meeting for

October 11, 2022

After the pledge, Chairman Jimmy Allred brought the meeting to order. Scott Romsas, from Ely, is running for County Commissioner seat 1, is here for the second month in a row to hear of our concerns and comments.

Ann Hamilton made a motion to approve the minutes of September 13, 2022 as written, Lorin Peacock seconded that motion and all members approved.

Vouchers for payment secretary wages, motioned by Lorin and seconded by Ann. All members approved.

Jimmy mentioned that there is one flashing street light but couldn't remember which one it was. Megan Pierce mentioned maybe we could possibly get turn signs so people don't use the middle lane as a passing lane through town. Lee will call the Sherriff's office to have them move the cop car, it has been sitting in the same spot for approximately 9 months. Jimmy still hasn't heard back about the speed limit signs for the back roads. Clean up projects, Lorin trimmed the trees around the stop sign at Brad Hayes, Lee and Ann will work on cleaning up the branches and taking them to the tree dump. Lorin suggested doing town clean ups once a month.

Public Comment: Lorin went to the county commission meeting in regards to a gun range. He mentioned we will need to do a lot of homework. He is holding a meeting at the community center this Friday October 14 at 7PM for gun owners interested in having a gun range for our white river valley. Some items to work on is getting a non-profit Board of Directors and finding available government land we could use. The county owns property SW of Preston against the mountain. Suggested keep grants under \$100,000 to keep the Fed's out of it. Dirt work and roads will be the biggest cost. Jimmy mentioned that when Mindy Seal worked at the BLM they were giving money for those projects if we find the land. Jared Bybee who is in charge at the BLM now doesn't agree. The gun range will have a fence and be locked and only certain people will have the keys. The gun range details include 1) small arm pistol range 2) rifle range 100-1000 yards 3) cleared area for shotguns, clay pigeons.

Lee motioned to adjourn, Lorin seconded and all members approved. The next meeting will be on November 8 @ 6pm @ the Lund Community Building.
